When will the park re-open?

The park will re-open on Friday 18 September 2020.

Who can stay?

Anyone travelling from regional Victoria can make a booking. The park will not be accepting bookings from people who live in the metropolitan Melbourne.

Do I need my own self-contained caravan?

No, however we strongly encourage using self-contained facilities if you have them.

Will any park facilities be open?

Amenity blocks, camp kitchen and bottom laundry will be open. Dump points will be available. Games room will remain closed.

Will facilities be cleaned for frequently?

Yes. All park communal facilities will be cleaned at least two times a day.

Do I need to complete any additional paperwork?

Yes. Due to COVID-19, all guests need to complete a self-assessment declaration before checking in. This will be used for contact tracing if requested by the Department of Health and Human Services.

When can I book a site for Christmas?

We will begin taking new Christmas bookings after current Christmas bookings are confirmed. We will advise all current Christmas bookings of any further updates as they are received.



Can I have a fire?

Yes, fires are permitted outside fire season as long as they are small, 300mm raised from the ground and in an enclosed fire pit.

Will the Kiosk be open?

Yes, the kiosk will be available 9-4 daily for window service only.
