What to Expect	Assembly Area	When to Go
<p>Limited visibility during fires or storms</p> <p>Restricted access to Bruthen &amp; District</p> <p>Assembly area will be crowded and you will be told what to do</p> <p>Loss of power and telephone communications</p> <p>Town water and electricity supply may fail. <b>Do not</b> rely on town water or electricity supply for fire fighting purposes. Remember, cordless telephones rely on power which may be unavailable</p>	<p><b>Assembly Area</b></p> <p><b>Bruthen Mechanics Institute Precinct</b></p> <p><b>Main Street Bruthen</b></p> <p><b>This is the designated 'Assembly Area' during a local incident - Fire, Flood, Storm, Accident.</b></p> <p><b>THIS IS NOT A REFUGE OR NEIGHBOURHOOD SAFER PLACE LOCATION</b></p>	<p>When you hear an incident is impacting or will impact the Bruthen &amp; District</p> <p>When advised by CFA, DELWP, SES, Police or local radio</p> <p>When leaving your home, close windows, doors, curtains, drapes, blinds; turn off lights, air conditioning and gas bottles</p> <p><b>LEAVE EARLY !</b></p>
