| What to Expect | <u>Assembly Area</u> | When to Go |
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| <p>Limited visibility during fires or storms</p> <p>Limited or restricted access to Raymond Island</p> <p>To be crowded and to be told what to do</p> <p>Remember, cordless telephones rely on power</p> <p>Loss of power and telephone communications</p> <p>Do not rely on town water or electricity supply for fire fighting purposes.</p> | <p>Community Hall Corner Fifth Parade & Sixth Avenue Raymond Island</p> <p>This is the designated Assembly Area during a local Incident, be it Fire, Flood, Storm, Accident etc.</p> | <p>Go Early</p> <p>When you hear that an incident is impacting or will impact on the Raymond Island area</p> <p>When advised by CFA, DELWP, SES, Victoria Police or local radio.</p> <p>When leaving your home, close all windows and doors, close curtains, drapes, blinds, turn off lights and air conditioning.</p> |

| <p>Understand the risks and develop a personal / family incident survival plan and rehearse your plan</p> <p>Pack an 'Emergency Kit' including items from 'What to Take'</p> <p>Prepare your house to give it the best chance of surviving an incident.</p> | | |
| <p>What to Wear</p> <p>Fire Natural fibre (wool or cotton), long sleeve top and long pants, solid footwear (leather), wide brimmed hat, smoke mask and a towel.</p> <p>Flood - Solid footwear (leather)</p> | | |
| What to Take | Publications | Monitor Local Radio for Emergency Warnings |
| <p>Medications for 7 days / toiletries for at least 3 days</p> <p>Prescriptions</p> <p>Essential clothing, photos, personal items, woollen blanket, food and drinking water</p> <p>Documents - passport, titles, bank accounts, birth, marriage and insurance certificates</p> <p>Mobile phone, charger, portable radio, torch and batteries</p> <p>Pet food, leads, cages and bowls.</p> | <p>CFA Fire Ready Kit, Raymond Island Community information guide.</p> <p>SES Emergency Toolkit - Flood, Tsunami, Storm, and Quake Safe</p> <p>RED CROSS Emergency REDiPlan</p> | <p>Local Radio Stations</p> <p>ABC 100.7 FM ABC 828 AM REG FM 105.5 FM</p> |
