## Bairnsdale streetscape work restarts

Work on the streetscape upgrade in Nicholson Street, Bairnsdale will start again on **Friday 1 February**, following a pause over the busy Christmas trading period.

These works will begin at the roundabout before progressing down Nicholson Street. The design includes raised pedestrian crossings, new tree plantings, seats, lighting, and footpath upgrades to create a space that encourages a walkable central business district.

### Intention to sell land

East Gippsland Shire Council gives public notice in accordance with Section 189 of the *Local Government Act 1989* (the Act) that it intends to sell an area of approximately 191m<sup>2</sup> located at 5B Grevillia Avenue Metung. The land is to be sold via private treaty to the adjoining land owner for consolidation with their existing allotment.
