Lindenow-Glenaladale Road Bridge Replacement Project Update

At the December 2016 Council meeting, the contract to replace the Lindenow-Glenaladale Road bridge was awarded to Jarvis Norwood Constructions. The scope of works for the contract includes:

- Replace current bridge with a reinforced concrete and steel structure.
- Replace the existing main span steel truss with a structure that helps to retain the aesthetics of the current bridge.
- Protection of the existing East Gippsland Water main and transfer of the water main to new structure.
- Install bridge barrier railing and safety barrier across the structure and on the approaches.
- Tie-in road works and bitumen seal the road approaches.

The estimated date for the bridge closure is March/April 2017. It is anticipated that the project may take up to 52 weeks. During this time local residents will need to use an alternate route via Bairnsdale-Dargo Road to access properties on the western side of the bridge.

You are invited to attend a community information session where council officers and the construction team will be able to answer any questions you may have about the bridge closure. An exact date for the bridge closure will also be available at the information session. An agenda for the meeting is attached to this newsletter.

Lindenow Recreation Reserve Pavilion Kitchen Upgrade

An upgraded kitchen in the Lindenow Recreation Reserve Pavilion will make it much more efficient and safer for volunteers on games days and when catering for special events. The new kitchen is a major upgrade to the existing facility and will be a commercial grade kitchen with internal and external serveries.

The project value is \$60,000 with East Gippsland Shire Council contributing \$30,000 and the Lindenow Recreation Reserve Committee of Management funding the remaining \$30,000. The project is due for completion by the end of March.

Lindenow Netball Court Project

The Lindenow Netball Court Project will see two new netball courts developed on the site of the old tennis courts. The new netball courts will have a multi-coloured synthetic non-slip surface, a new large shelter and storage area and lighting for night training and competition.

The total cost of the project is around \$145,000 with Sport and Recreation Victoria contributing \$85,000, the Lindenow Recreation Reserve Committee of Management providing \$40,000 and East Gippsland Shire Council contributing \$20,000. The new courts are well underway with the expected opening in April 2017 in time for this year's football/netball season.

Lindenow Cricket Club Storage/Shelter Project

The Lindenow Cricket Club has for many years been making do with a very small timber shed as their only storage and shelter facility. A new facility is now being constructed to replace the shed. It is several times larger than the old facility and includes a lockable storage area and plenty of external shelter for shade and rain protection.

The total value of the project is around \$20,000, with East Gippsland Shire Council providing \$15,000. The Lindenow Cricket Club funded the remaining \$5,000 and will be doing the work to pull down the old facility and install the new facility.
